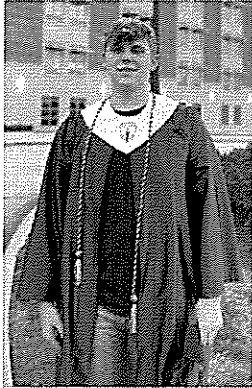

Madeline Buffington

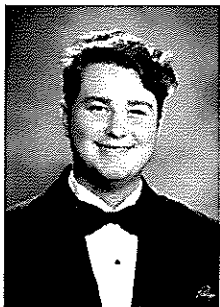

Matthew Carey



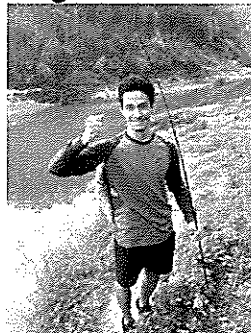
Matthew is a 4 year Klein High School swimmer. He loves his team mates, the comradery, the coaches, and traditions that continue through this program.

Erin Holladay



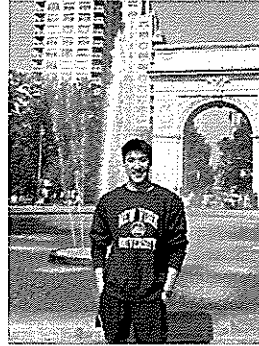

Joshua Le



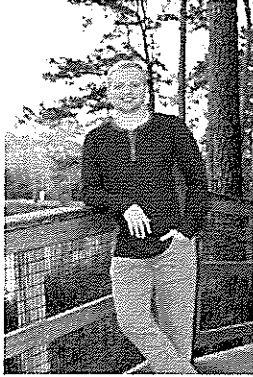

Mary O'Sullivan



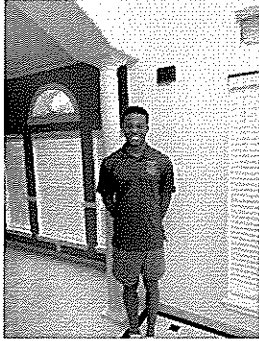

Jillian Urrutia



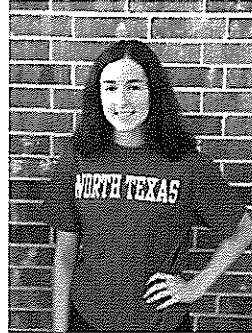

Angela Wu

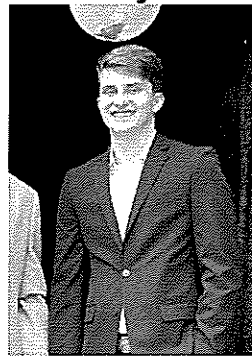


Angela is a four-year JV swimmer. Angela has swam competitively since she was six, with the Colony Creek Mariners.
